


**PARTS LIST**

### DRYWALL MOUNTING:

Attach the apron rack directly to the wall studs.

If it is not possible to affix the apron rack directly to the wall studs, then install a plywood panel spanning the two wall studs.

Then affix the apron rack to the panel.



**Note:** The panel must be able to support the weight of 150lbs.

## CONCRETE WALL MOUNTING:

Mount using 150lb concrete anchor and concrete screws

Use masonry drill and drill the hole 1/2 inch deeper than the 150 lb concrete anchor. Use a hammer to drive the anchor into the hole until the anchor head rests on the concrete surface.

Install rack into the anchors using concrete screws.

You are done!



**Note:** The concrete anchor must be able to support 150lbs.
